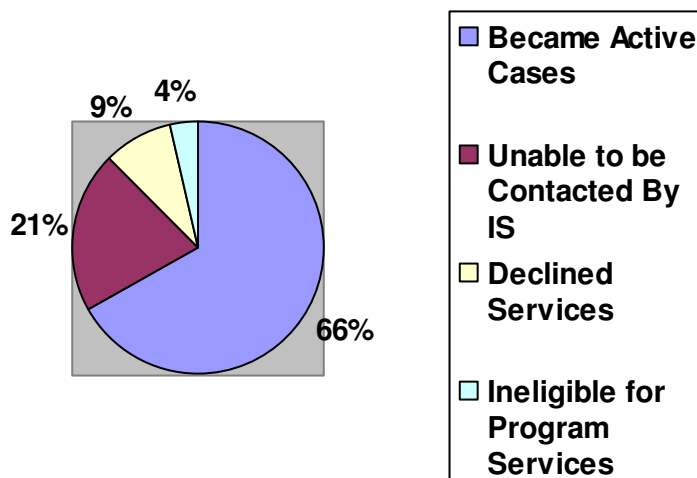

Outcome of All Highland Referrals Received During 2008:



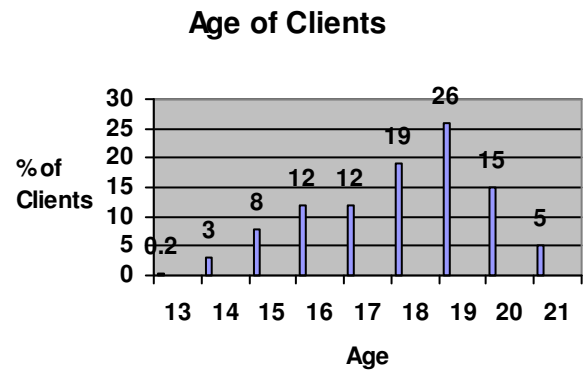
OUTCOMES:

- 92% of clients were **not hospitalized for a violence-related injury.**
- 88% of clients were **not arrested for a new offense.**
- 19 clients got a **new job**
- 22 clients got **enrolled/re-enrolled in school** (includes traditional middle/high schools, alternative schools and home school/independent study)
- 34 clients **participated in an educational support program** (includes tutoring & GED preparation)
- 10 clients **earned a GED or high school diploma**
- 8 clients got **enrolled in college**
- 2 clients **completed probation**

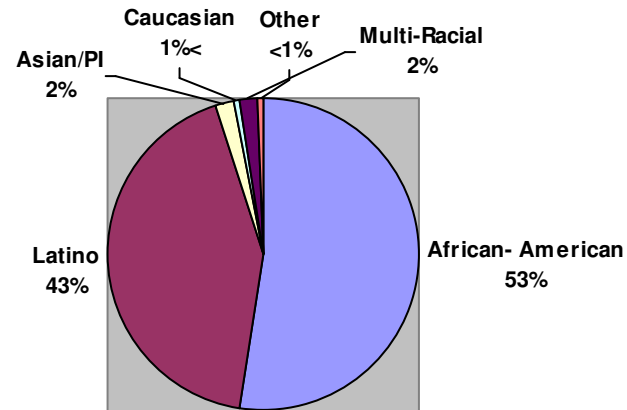

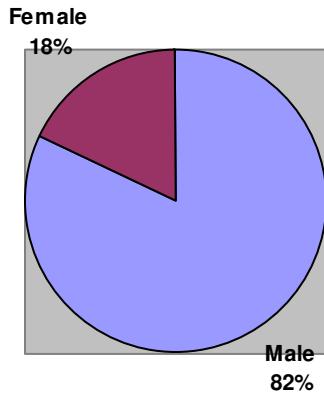

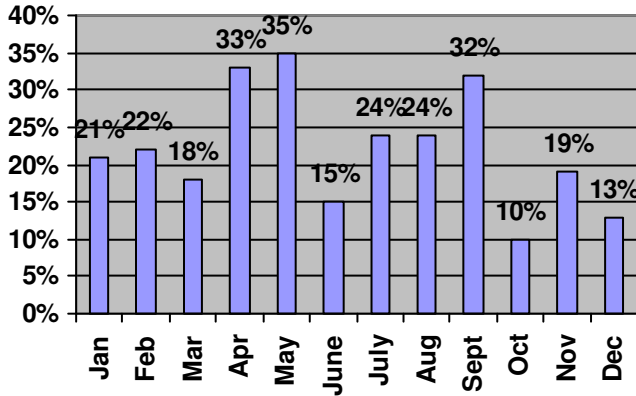

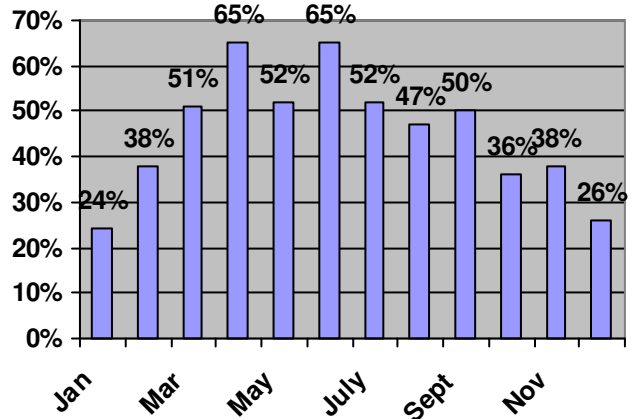
(% of Highland clients receiving or participating in services 1/1/08-12/31/08):

Vocational assistance: Average=22%

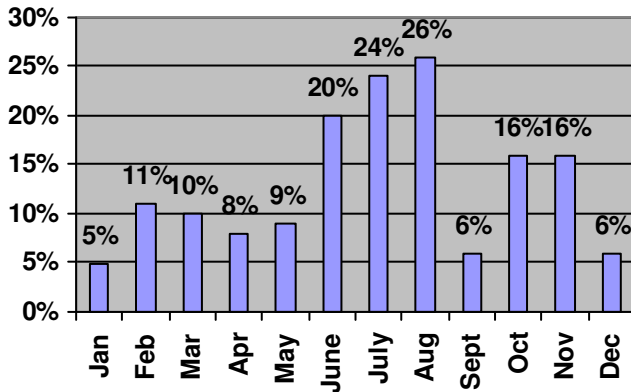


Assistance with health care services:

Average=45%

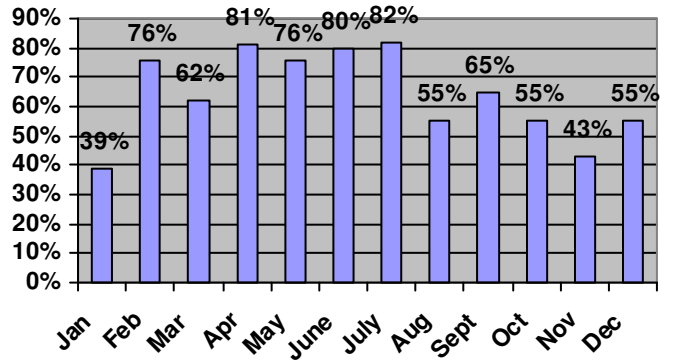


Counseling: Average=13%
